

**BOSCOBEL MUNICIPAL UTILITIES – ELECTRIC
RATES EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2010**

This summary will enable you to check your bill. The information shown is only general. A complete schedule is on file at our office and is available for details.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE (PCAC)

All metered rates shall be subject to a positive or negative power cost adjustment charge equivalent to the amount by which the current cost power is greater or lesser than the base cost of power purchased or produced. The base cost until changed by the Public Service Commission is \$0.0747 per KWH.

Residential Service

FIXED CHARGE PER MONTH \$7.00 ENERGY 9.09¢ per KWH plus PCAC

Small Power Service

Fixed Charge per month \$40.00 plus \$1.25 per KW of demand of highest monthly maximum measured demand in current or preceding 11-month period. Demand Charge \$7.00 per KW. Energy Charge 5.6¢ per KWH. Minimum monthly bill is Fixed Charges.

General Service

Fixed charge per month \$8 for single phase, \$16 for three phase, Energy Charge 9.59¢ per KWH, minimum monthly bill is Fixed Charge.

Large Power Service

Fixed charge per month \$150 plus \$1.75 per KW of demand of highest monthly maximum measured demand in current or preceding 11-month period. Demand Charge \$8.00 per KW. Energy Charge 7.15¢ On-Peak and 4.14¢ Off-Peak per KWH. Minimum monthly bill is Fixed Charges.

PROMPT PAYMENT OF BILLS

A charge of no more than 1% per month will be added to bills not paid within 20 days from date of issuance. This late payment charge shall be applied to the total unpaid balance for utility service, including unpaid payment charges. This charge is applicable to all customers. The utility customer may be given a written notice no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued and unless payment or satisfactory arrangement for payment is made within the next 10 days, service may be disconnected pursuant to the Wis. Adm. Code, section PSC 113.

PROMPT PAYMENT OF BILLS

A charge of no more than 1% per month will be added to bills not paid within 20 days from date of issuance. This late payment charge shall be applied to the total unpaid balance for utility service, including unpaid payment charges. This charge is applicable to all customers. The utility customer may be given a written notice no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued and unless payment or satisfactory arrangement for payment is made within the next 10 days, service may be disconnected pursuant to the Wis. Adm. Code, section PSC 185.
